

AREA SHOOTING RANGES

VILAS COUNTY SHOOTING RANGE

Location: 4.5 miles south of Conover off of U.S. Highway 45. Road is next road south of Chicago Avenue.

Range Rules:

The Range is open for your enjoyment spring, summer and fall during daylight hours within the period of 7:00am to 8:00pm.

Rifles and pistols are to be shot only into the backstops. Targets shall not at any time be placed on top of the backstops.

Whenever a person is down range for any reason, all individuals on the range shall cease firing, unload and break open the actions on their weapons.

Glass targets shall not be used.

Users of the range must remove all refuse (cans, plastic containers, paper, shell casings, etc.) from the range when finished and must dispose of such refuse at an appropriate disposal site.

Alcoholic beverages and containers are absolutely prohibited and shall not be consumed on or brought to the range.

BOULDER JUNCTION SHOOTING RANGE

Open to the public with a rifle and pistol shelter and 300 yard range. The trap and skeet area, equipped with voice pulls, is comprised of 3 trap fields and 2 skeet fields. A new Five Stand field has been added to one of the skeet fields. A spacious club house provides a panoramic view of the activities.

One of the friendliest ranges you'll ever enjoy, it's maintained by volunteers.

Hours of Operation:

Trap, Skeet, Wobble Skeet are open every Sunday and Wednesday year round, from noon to 4 P.M. The Five Stand is also open, weather permitting. Come join us. All shooting activities are open to the public. For more information, call either Mike at 715-547-8307 or Pete at 715-543-2264.

Highway M, 5.6 MILES NORTH OF HIGHWAY 51 – 4.3 MILES SOUTH OF BOULDER JUNCTION - Nebish Lake Road, east of DNR Trout Lake Forestry HG.

Rates:

The 2013 shooting fee schedule is as follows:

Skeet, trap, or five stand is \$5.00 per round.

Donor/Members pay \$4.00 per round for skeet, trap, or five stand.

Prepaid 20 round punch cards are available to donors at a discounted rate.

Shells are available for purchase at the office of the club house.

There are no fees for the use of the rifle and pistol ranges but donations are appreciated.
