

AREA PARKS & BEACHES

There are several parks and beaches available for family fun offering a variety of enjoyment including picnic areas and shelters, beaches, playgrounds, boat launches, fishing piers, tennis, volleyball and basketball courts, and baseball fields.

BIG ARBOR VITAE PARK & BEACH: Located on Big Arbor Vitae Lake which is just off of Hwy. 70 in Arbor Vitae. Boat landing, beach, restrooms, picnic area.

BOND FALLS: Bond Falls is one of those "best kept secret" spots on the Western Upper Peninsula that you want to make sure you do not miss. This beautiful water fall is located on the middle branch of the Ontonagon River near Paulding. Although it does not get the "press" of more famous U.P. water falls, Bond Falls has a large following of admirers and had even been part of a calendar listing the most scenic natural places in the world!

CLEAR LAKE PARK & BEACH: Located in Woodruff, east of town, off Hwy. J, picnic area, beach, restrooms.

CRYSTAL LAKE CAMPGROUND: Located between Sayner and Boulder Junction, off Hwy. N, picnic area, beach, restrooms.

EAGLE LAKE COUNTY PARK & BEACH: Located just off Chain O' Lakes Road in Eagle River. Beach, boat landing, dock, picnic area, playground and restrooms.

RIVERVIEW PARK: Eagle River, west of Hwy. 45 N, along Eagle River. Shelter, dock, picnic area, playground and restrooms. Boat tie-up and fishing pier.

SILVER LAKE: Silver Lake Rd., Eagle River. Beach with lifeguard, changing rooms, picnic area and pan fishing pier.

ST. GERMAIN COMMUNITY PARK: Hwys. 70 & 155. Ball field, shelter, tennis court, playground and restrooms.

VANDERVORT PARK: Lost Lake Drive North in St. Germain. Ball field and public pier.
